## **General Instructions.**

- 1.1. The Interested bidders may download the tender documents from the website www.jktenders.gov.in from 15.04.2024 to 07.05.2024 upto 2.00 p.m.
- Online bids in two parts i.e. technical bid (Part 1) and Financial bid (Part 2) shall be submitted on the website www.jktenders.gov.in from 16.04.2024 to 07.05.2024 upto 2:00 P.M.
- 1.3. Clarifications if any will be entertained from 15.04.2024 to 25.04.2024 upto 2:00 PM.
- 1.4. The technical bids uploaded on the website will be opened on 08-05-2024 at 2:00 PM in the office chamber of Chairman, Divisional State Level Purchase Committee, Sheep Husbandry Department JandK, Kashmir (Director Sheep Husbandry Department, Agriculture Complex, Lal Mandi Srinagar Kashmir. In case, the said date is declared as holiday the bids will be opened on the next working day at the same time.
- 1.5. The above schedule regarding date and time is tentatively fixed, however, the Chairman DLPC reserves the right to change thedate and time of activities in case of any exigency through a notice on e-tendering portal www.jktenders.gov. in and on official website of the Directorate of Sheep Husbandry Kashmir.
- 1.6. Disclosure of rate/discounts special offers in the technical bid may be understood as mal practice and as such the bid shall berejected.
- 1.7. All the original documents should be produced at the time of scrutiny, if asked for by the technical evaluation committee.
- 1.8. The DLPC reserves the right to accept or reject any tender or any part of the tender before, during or after the tender without assigning any reason thereof.
- 1.9. No conditional tender will be accepted entertained.
- 1.10. The bidder has to submit a non-refundable tender fee of Rs 500/= in form of a demand draft (hard copy) in favour of Member secretary Accounts Officer Sheep Husbandry Department Kashmir.
- 1.11. The tenders without tender fee shall be out rightly rejected. Firms that are eligible for exemption for the payment have to submit and upload the scanned document in support of such exemption.

# 2. Eligibility

- 2.1. All Manufacturers/suppliers of the Rabbit Feed shall be eligible for participation of the tenders.
- 2.2. Apart from the above necessary eligible criteria other documents required from the bidder as envisaged in the other conditions of the tender documents are mandatory for being eligible in the present proposal of the tender.
- 2.3. The minimum average annual turnover of bidder and in case of supplier of the principal manufacturer for financial year 2020-2021,2021-22,2022-23, should be Rs 5.00 lakhs. The certificate to the effect issued by practicing Chartered Accountant should be uploaded (Annexure 2) along with the copy of balance sheet of the bidder and in case of supplier of the principal manufacturer duly attested by chartered accountant for the financial year2020-21,2021-22,2022-23. The turnover should be in terms of Rabbit feed exclusively.

# **3.Micro and Small Enterprises and SSI Units**

- 3.1. Bidders claiming relaxation for MSE's /SSI have to submit a valid Udhyog aadhar certificate.
- 3.2. Participating Micro and Small Enterprises quoting price within price band of L1+15 % shall also be allowed to supply a portion of requirement by bringing down their price to L1 price in a situation where L1 price is from someone other than a micro small and medium enterprise. In case of more than one such Micro and Small Enterprises the supply shall be shared proportionately. This relaxation is in view of the procurement policy for MSE's. This is also with the objective of achieving minimum of 25% of annual purchases by Micro and Small Enterprises. Within 25% , a purchase preference of 4% shall be reserved for MSE owned by scheduled caste/scheduled tribe entrepreneurs and 3% is reserved for MSE's owned by women entrepreneurs(if they participate in the tender process and match L1 price). However in the event of failure of such MSE's to participate in tender process or meet tender requirement at L1 price 4% sub target for procurement earmarked for MSE's owned SC/ST entrepreneurs and 3% earmarked to women entrepreneurs will be met from other MSE's. MSE's would be treated as owned by SC/ST.
- 3.3 In case of MSE's the condition of submission of EMD has been relaxed instead they shall submit a security bid declaration in the form of annexure 3(a).

# **4.EMD/Performance Security**

4.1 Bid security/earnest money for an amount of Rs 25000/- Twenty five thousand only in the form of accounts payee demand draft, fixed deposit favouring A.O Sheep Husbandry Kashmir, Lal Mandi, Srinagar J & K initially valid for a period of 6 months to be extended further as per finalization of the contract. The bidder has to upload scanned copy of CDR/FDR/DD with the bid and hard copy shall be submitted by the last date of the submission of bid. EMD of unsuccessful bidders will be returned to them at an earliest after the award of contract to successful bidder but the department shall not be responsible for any loss or depreciation that may occur as hither-to-fore while in its possession nor be liable to pay any interest thereof. EMD shall be refunded to the successful bidder on receipt of performance security. Tenders without EMD shall be rejected. In case of MSE's the condition of submission of EMD has been relaxed instead they shall submit a security bid declaration in the form of annexure 3(a).

4.2:- The successful bidder shall have to deposit refundable performance security equal to 5% of the supply value of the purchase order in favor of AO Sheep Husbandry Kashmir/Purchase Officer as the case may be at the time of receipt of the supply order. In case of failure to make the said deposit, the contract shall be cancelled. The security deposit shall be liable to be forfeited by order generating authority for non/short supply of the ordered item in stipulated time frame from the receipt of order. Partial deposit or previous deposit of the security money for any supply order will not be entertained and new security deposit should be submitted for each supply order. The performance security will also be forfeited in the event of breach of contract or unsatisfactory supplies. Security money deposited will be refunded after satisfactory completion of the supply and a certificate pertaining to this will be issued to the supplier. No proportionate refund of the security money will be allowed if the supplied quantity falls below the ordered quantity.

# 4. TECHNICAL BID

**5.1** <u>Application:-</u> Bidder will have to upload the prescribed application format (Annexure 1) duly filled in signed and affixed with the seal of the firm byindicating full communicating address with Pincode, Telephone No, Fax and others.

## 5.2 <u>Turnover Criteria:</u>-

The minimum average annual turnover of bidder and in case of supplier of the principal manufacturer for financial year 2020-2021,2021-22,2022-23, should be Rs 5.00 lakhs. The certificate to the effect issued by practicing Chartered Accountant should be uploaded (Annexure 2) along with the copy of balance sheet of the bidder and in case of supplier of the principal manufacturer duly attested by chartered accountant for the financial year2020-21,2021-22,2022-23. The turnover should be in terms of Rabbit feed exclusively.

## 5.3 <u>Tender Fee:-</u>

Copy of demand draft FOR Rs.500/=on account of tender fee should be uploaded. The original demand draft should be submitted to Member Secretary DLPC (AO Sheep Husbandry Department Kashmir). Valid exemptions certificate for exemption of tender fee issued under price preference rules for MSME's/SSI units should be uploaded.

## 5.5 SELF DECLARATION:-

Each bidder has to upload a self-attested( with seal) Non Blacklisting certificate that the firm has not been blacklisted in the past byany Government or Private Institutions.

- Affidavit duly attested by the notary declaring that:
  - a) The documents enclosed with the tender are original and genuine and have not been tempered or fabricated.
  - b) There is no Vigilance/CBI case pending against the bidder and in case of intermediary of both the Principal and the intermediary.
  - c) All the terms & conditions of NIT are acceptable to us.

## 5.6 INCOME TAX RETURN

- Copy of Income Tax Return of the bidder and in case of intermediary of both the Principal and the intermediary for the year 2020-21,2021-22,2022-23(assessment year).
- Copy of PAN card of the bidder and in case of supplier of both the Principal and the supplier.

# 5.7 GST REGISTRATION:-

- Copy of GST registration certificate of the bidder and in case of supplier of both the Principal and the supplier.
- Bidder should also upload a GST return file copy/Tax clearance certificate for 3rd quarter of 2023-24.
- 5.7.1 Letter of authority from the Principal Manufacturer (in case the firm is not a manufacturer).
- 5.8 Copy of manufacturing License (with complete manufacturing address)certificate should be uploaded with the technical bid. Exemptions if any be also uploaded.
- 5.9 SSI units have to upload original GST registration certificate issued byconcerned DIC.
- 5.10 The bidder must display on the label of the pack, the quantities ofeach ingredient, as well as comply with good labelling practices .

## **6.FINANCIAL BID:**

- 6.1 The financial bid shall be made online only on the website www.jktenders.gov.in. Disclosure of rates/discounts/special offers in the technical bid may be understood as malpractice and such bid may be rejected.
- 6.2 Financial bids of only technically qualified bidders shall be opened.

# <u>7.RATE</u>

- 7.1 The rates offered in the tender shall under no circumstances exceed the MRP as well as the lowest price at which the firm sells the product of the identical description to any other department/ organization or person anywhere in the open market in the state. If incident of quoting higher rate to this department comes to the notice at any point of time during the course of rate contract period undersigned reserves the right to initiate an appropriate action againstsuch firms including Blacklisting, Recovery of excess amount paid as well as forfeiture of performance security.
- 7.2 Rates shall be uniform and inclusive of delivery charges and all other incidental charges e.g. Loading unloading, cost of transportation, packing for Rabbit Farm Wussan Baramulla Kashmir.
- 7.3 GST should be mentioned separately in the whole amount in the dedicated column in the bill of quantity.
- 7.4 L1 will be determined on the base price only without GST.
- 7.5 The rate is/are to be quoted in INR or Paisa in net decimal coinage only.

- 7.6 Enhancement of rate under no circumstance will be accepted for whatever the reasons
- 7.7 Abnormally low rate of any items quoted by the bidder in the offer without sufficient reason if detected will not be accepted. The Chairman DLPC reserves the right to reject any or all tenders at any stage without assigning any reason thereof. The rates quoted by the bidder shall not exceed the controlled rates if the Government rates are low on the date of uploading the tender. The bidder should quote reasonable price applicable to bulk purchases however quantity order may not likely be enough to be considered as truck load the bidder must however execute the supply of any quantity of ordered item.

#### **8.PERIOD OF RATE CONTRACT**

8.1 The Rate contract shall remain valid for a period of 1 year from the date of issuance or till the new rate contract is issuedwhichever is earlier.

#### **9.AGREEMENT**

- 9.1 The successful bidder will have to enter into a contractual agreement with the Representative of department of Sheep Husbandry Kashmir within 15 days after award of the contract on the non-judicial stamp paper worth Rs 20/= at their own cost. In the event of failure to execute the agreement in the prescribed manner within the stipulated period by the successful bidder shall forgo the right of the bidder to participate infuture tenders of the directorate.
- 9.2 The agreement should be typed only on one side of the stamp paper duly signed by authorized signatory on each page. The continued pages should be typed on the conquest paper.
- 9.3 The parties to the contract are the firm and the department of Sheep Husbandry J & K duly represented by the Chairman DLPC.
- 9.4 The person signing the tender, any other document forming part of tender on behalf of the firm shall be deemed to warned he/she has the authority to bind the firm in all the matters pertaining to the contract. If at any stage it is found that the person concerned has no such authority, the department may without prejudice to civil/criminal remedies, terminate the contract and hold the signatory liable for all costs & damages.

#### 10.SUPPLY and DELIVERY

- 10.1. Orders for the supply of the approved products will be placed with the successful bidders after the execution of supplies as and when required by the procuring authorities, as and when depending upon their annual consumption. Fresh stock as per the manufacturing batch shall have to be supplied against all indents within stipulated time frame as may be envisaged in supply order.
- 10.2. The order item must be packed suitably to avoid transit loss and weathering to maintain quality.

- 10.3. The Rabbit Feed should be free from extraneous materials like cobs, adulterants, metal pieces etc. it should be rancid, stale fermented, dusty or having any bad odour. It should have acceptable texture that is firm and not faint. It should be free from toxins, fungus, insecticides or insect infestation. It should be packed in such freshbags which are not torn and are safe for storage purpose.
- 10.4. The supplier shall have to provide a certificate to the department at the time of supplies that the items supplied are infection free and moreover the supplies made are from the areas where no infection/disease were prevailing at the time purchase was made.
- 10.5. It is obligatory for the bidder to note that failure to maintain the delivery schedule of supply of ordered item would be considered as violation of terms and conditions and liable to penalty as per tender conditions.
- 10.6. Replacement of supply against any rejected consignment must be made positively within the given time frame from the date of intimation, failing which action shall be taken as per tender rules.
- 10.7. The tendering authority reserves the right to test the rabbit feed under subject in any govt./govt. approved /NABL accredited laboratory having such facilities and the test report will be binding for taking positive action/cancellation of whole supply order. The tendering authority reserves the right not to disclose the identity of test house. In the event of non standard and defective supply the batch will be destroyed and if the payment of such batch has already been made, the cost shall be recovered from the firm besides forfeiture of the security deposit. Such firms shall be debarred from supplying the rabbit feed etc and also blacklisted. The charges for testing shall beborne by the supplier.
- 10.8. The decision of the Chairman DLPC regarding the quality of the feed shall be final and binding on the approved supplier.
- 10.9. No request for additions/alterations/change in the brand name/specifications etc for the supply as a whole or individual items, shall be acceptable by the department once the contract has been finalized.

#### **11.PAYMENT**

- 11.1. The tax invoice against all supplies will be sent in triplicate and invariably be submitted along with the supplies for payment to Indenting Officer. The payment shall be made after satisfactory completion of the supply order (FOR destination) i.e. consignment delivered, verified, accepted and properly entered into stock register. No advance payment shall be made under any circumstances.
- 11.2. Payment shall be made after satisfactory completion of the contract in all respects however no interest shall be paid to the supplier (successful bidder) in the event of delay in making payment due to whatsoever reasons. In no circumstances delivery schedule should be affected or linked with the payment of outstanding bills. The payment of bills will be withheld in case of violations.
- 11.3. All due payments shall be made after deductions of applicable TDS.
- 11.4. It shall be obligatory upon every successful bidder to certify on each and every bill that

quoted rates are reasonable and are same as are being charged to other government or any other semi government institutes.

#### 12. PENAL ACTION

- 12.1. If the bidder refuses to enter into written agreement for the required supply within the time specified when requested to do so by the department or refuse to deposit the security money. Such firm's offer will not be taken into consideration and shall be liable to be blacklisted for next 3 years from the date of reporting.
- 12.2. The deposited security money furnished by supplier is liable tobe forfeited in full by order generating authority and order amount willbe cancelled without prejudice, in the event of failure/refusal to deliver as per the schedule, on the recommendations by the order generating authority Chairman DLPC will be at liberty to terminate the contract as whole or a part.
- 12.3. The quoted rate shall not exceed the price at which bidder sells the product of identical description to any other government directorate, organization, private institution etc if such instances of higher rates comes to notice, the authority deserves the right to cancel and blacklist the firm.
- 12.4. In case the delivery programme is not followed or the bidder backs out in that case the excess cost incurred on account of repurchase will be borne by the firm. Besides non-maintenance of delivery schedule /stoppage of supply may lead to termination of contract along with forfeiture of security money and the firm shall be liable to be blacklisted for next 3 years from the date of reporting.
- 12.5. In case of partial quantity of material delivered within the stipulated time 10% of basic cost of material not supplied will be deducted from existing bill of supplier as penalty, besides forfeiture of security money in full. However if the stipulated period ends on Sunday or govt. holidays, supply should be made on next working day and inthat case no penalty shall be chargeable. The defaulting firm may be blacklisted after issuance of a show cause notice. The names of the defaulting suppliers will be also be uploaded on the departmental website.
- 12.6. In case the test results for particular batch of feed reveal that supplies made are substandard, spurious, the same shall be destroyed and eventuality arising by use of the feed at field shall be at the cost of supplier. The supplier is bound to pay the expenses and the mattershall also be referred to the competent authority for initiation of action under rules besides blacklisting the firm.
- 12.7. The firm shall be responsible for any such outbreak which may occur due to any contagious disease in case it is proved to be due to the feed supplied. The department shall be at liberty to impose any penalty besides initiating legal proceedings on account of any losses occurred to Government Livestock.
- 12.8. Non-compliance of terms and Conditions laid herein shall constitute the breach of contract and Non compliance shall be enforced very rigidly.

#### **13.MISCELLANEOUS**

- 13.1. The successful Tenderer shall not assign or sublet the contract in part or in full to any other agency. In all such cases the contract shall be cancelled.
- 13.2. Any condition that is not indicated in the NIT can be incorporated in the supply order before the agreement for execution of the contract, if needed.
- 13.3. GFR, Manual for procurement of goods and services and any other latest guidelines issued by the government pertaining to purchase of stores, shall be followed, even if, there is no specific instruction in this tender document.
- 13.4. All the issues that may come up during the completion of contract shall be decided by DLPC J& K and the decision of the Chairman DLPC Sheep Husbandry Department J&K and the decisionshall be final and binding upon the firm.
- 13.4.1.1. That in case of any dispute Principal Secretary ASHF shall be the arbitrator and his decision shall be final and binding on the parties.
- 13.5. The seat of arbitration shall be Srinagar.
- 13.5.1. The language of the arbitration shall be English.
- 13.6. The laws governing arbitration shall be the laws of India.
- 13.7. When a tendering firm submits there tender in response tothis notification they will be deemed to have understood fully, contents, requirement, terms and conditions of tender. No extra payment will be made on the pretext that tendering firm did not have any clear ideas of a particular point. Any offer made in the response of this tender when accepted by tendering authority will constitute a contract between the parties.
- 13.8. All notices intended to be served to the bidder will be deemed to have been duly served, if sent by the registered post to address mentioned in the tender or any other address permissible by law. All the instructions either given in catalogue of items, tender notice, forms are binding upon the bidder. In the event of delay/non-availability, garbled printout, inaccessible website for downloading tender documents, the tender signing authority shall not be held responsible. Every document uploaded should be clearly visible otherwise it will not be considered.
- 13.9. There should be no vigilance or CBI Case pending against the supplier, self attested certificate to this effect should be submitted.
- 13.10. Force majeure clause shall not be acceptable.
- 13.11. Tenders should be typed partly handwritten/over written shall be rejected.
