1. General Instructions.

- 1.1: The Interested bidders may download the tender documents from the website www.jktenders.gov.in from 11-06-2022 to 04-07-2022
- 1.2: Online bids in two parts i.e. technical bid (Part 1) and Financial bid (Part 2) shall be submitted on the website www.jktenders.gov.infrom 11-06-2022 to 04-07-2022
- 1.3: Clarifications if any will be entertained from 11-06-2022 to 20-06-2022
- 1.4: The technical bids uploaded on the website will be opened on 05-07-2022 at 2:00 p.m in the office chamber of Chairman, State Level Purchase Committee, Sheep Husbandry Department JandK, Kashmir (Director Sheep Husbandry Department, Agriculture Complex, LalMandi Srinagar Kashmir in presence of bidders who wish to be present. In case, the said date is declared as holiday the bids will be opened on the next working day at the same time.
- 1.5: The above schedule regarding date and time is tentatively fixed, however, the Chairman SLPC reserves the right to change the date and time of activities in case of any exigency through a notice on etenderingportalwww.jktenders.gov.inandon official website of the Directorate of Sheep Husbandry Kashmir.
- 1.6: Tenders received after due date and time shall not be accepted.
- 1.7: Disclosure of rate/discounts special offers in the technical bid may be understood as mal practice and as such the bid shall be rejected.
- 1.8: All the original documents should be produced at the time of scrutiny if asked by the technical evaluation committee.
- 1.9: The SLPC reserves the right to accept or reject any tender or any part of the tender before, during or after the tender without assigning any reason thereof.
- 1.10: No conditional tender will be accepted entertained.
- 1.11: The bidder has to submit a tender fee of Rs 2,500/= in form of a demand draft(hardcopy) in favor of Member secretary Accounts Officer Sheep Husbandry Department Kashmir.
- 1.12: The tenders without tender fee shall be out rightly rejected. Firms that are eligible for exemption for the payment have to submit and upload the scanned document in support of such exemption.

Expression of Interest Tender

Expression of Interest (EOI) in two bid system is invited from livestock dealers for supply of Livestock (Sheep/Goat) from States having similar agro-climatic conditions as Kashmir(except himachal pradesh and uttarkhand) for establishment of units under ISDS. In this connection the interested persons are hereby informed to express their interest through online submission of bids along with requisite documents on following terms and conditions:

- 1. Only female sheep having following technical parameters are to be supplied:
 - Body weight between 25-30 Kg's
 - Age 1.5 -2 years (Dentition not above 2T)
 - Devoid of any defects/ diseases/ disorders.
 - White Body without any colored spots.
- 2. The interested party should upload PAN card ,Aadhaar Card , self attested undertaking for experience in Livestock trade & Original Income Tax returns (if applicable) for last 3 Assessment years i.e, 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22 are to be uploaded .
- **3.** The interested party should preferably have its own transport or affiliation with any transport agency, the bidder should upload self attested undertaking to this effect.
- 4. The supplier will have to keep animals available within two months i.e. August & September 2022 at one site per district.

- 5. The animals meeting the technical parameters, which shall be adjudged by District level technical committee, shall be provided to beneficiaries after proper tagging immediately upon arriving at the Districts.
- No earnest money is to be deposited/submitted with the bid however bid security declaration duly self-attested as per finance department J&K Civil secretariat Jammu Srinagar Circular No. No.A/Misc(2018)-III-895/J DATED:-22-12-2020(Annexure – 3 a) should be kept in the bid documents.
- 7. The successful bidder shall have to deposit refundable performance security equal to 3% of the supply value of the Livestock in favor of the concerned DSHO at the time of execution of agreement. In case of failure to make the said deposit, the contract shall be cancelled. The security deposit shall be liable to be forfeited by order generating authority for non/short supply of the livestock. The performance security will also be forfeited in the event of breach of contract or unsatisfactory supplies. Security money deposited will be refunded after satisfactory completion of the supply.
- 8. Payments to the supplier shall be made by the beneficiaries through concerned DSHO's after receipt of each consignment and as per the guidelines of the scheme.
- 9. The supplier will be required to transport livestock as per rules in vogue keeping in view the welfare of animals. Each consignment shall have the details of the supplier/breeder (including name, parentage, address & contact No.) of the concerned state from which the livestock has been procured.
- 10. Cost per animal must not exceed Rs 10000/- (The party offering lowest price per animal will be preferred). The rate should be inclusive of all taxes and charges and other incidental charges including transportation cost.
- 11. The transportation cost upto Rs.500/ animal can be borne by the Department for which the rates should also be quoted separately. However L1 shall be determined on the basis of total rate quoted inclusive of transportation.
- 12. Any loss, death of the livestock etc. during the transition FOR destination shall be the responsibility of the supplier. No extra cost/payments shall be made in case of any loss incurred upto the delivery of the livestock to the beneficiaries.
- 13. The financial bid shall be made online only on the website <u>www.jktenders.gov.in</u>. Disclosure of rates/discounts/special offers in the technical bid may be understood as malpractice and such bid may be rejected.
- 14. The rates are to be quoted FOR Srinagar, however the supplier has to provide livestock to all the districts of Kashmir viz. Srinagar, Ganderbal, Budgam, Kupwara, Bandipora, Baramulla, Anantnag, Kulgam, Shopian & Pulwama at the same rate. The department shall not bear any cost incurred on this account.
- 15. Rate contract shall be valid for current financial year i.e 2022-23.
- 16. The successful bidder will have to enter into a contractual agreement with the concerned DSHO within 15 days after award of the contract on the non-judicial stamp paper worth Rs.20/= at their own cost. In the event of failure to execute the agreement within the stipulated period the successful bidder shall forego the right to participate in the future tenders of the department besides forfeiture of performance security.
- 17. The successful Tenderer shall not assign or sublet the contract in part or in full to any other agency. In all such cases the contract shall be cancelled
- 18. Any condition that is not indicated in the NIT can be incorporated in the Agreement before execution of the supply order, if needed.
- 19. GFR, Manual for procurement of goods and services and any other latest guidelines issued by the government pertaining to purchase of goods/services, shall be followed, even if, there is no specific instruction in this tender document.
- 20. All the issues that may come up during the completion of contract shall be decided by SLPC J& K and the decision of the Chairman SLPC Sheep Husbandry Department J&K and the decision shall be final and binding upon the firm.
- 21. Any legal proceedings shall be subject to jurisdiction of courts within Kashmir only.

- 22. When a tendering firm submits there tender in response to this notification they will be deemed to have understood fully, contents, requirement, terms and conditions of tender. No extra payment will be made on the pretext that tendering firm did not have any clear ideas of a particular point. Any offer made in the response of this tender when accepted by tendering authority will constitute a contract between the parties.
- 23. All notices intended to be served to the bidder will be deemed to have been duly served, if sent by the registered post to address mentioned in the tender or any other address permissible by law. All the instructions given in tender notice is binding upon the bidder. In the event of delay/non-availability, garbled printout, inaccessible website for downloading tender documents, the tender signing authority shall not be held responsible. Every document uploaded should be clearly visible otherwise it will not be considered.
- 24. There should be no vigilance or CBI Case pending against the supplier for which the supplier shall submit a self-attested declaration.
- 25. Force majeure clause shall not be acceptable.
- 26. Tenders should be typed, partly handwritten/over written shall be rejected.
